

# Slow Streets Are Coming to Our Streets!

LADOT is bringing its popular Slow Streets program to our neighborhood! On **September 18**, a network of streets in North Westdale will be slowed to through car traffic to encourage socially-distanced activities and exercise during the COVID-19 shutdown.

What is a Slow Street?

- Streets open to local residents in vehicles, riding bikes, on foot, etc...
- No parking restrictions are part of program.
- Slow Streets are NOT gathering spaces. Everyone is required to keep distance between themselves and people who are not members of the same household.
- If safe physical distance is not practiced, the program will end.
- Slow Streets are created through posting signage and barricades at key intersections (see pic on right).
- Slow Streets will not impede access for emergency vehicles, delivery trucks, people accessing the school, or visitors to the neighborhood.
- Slow Streets will not be enforced by LAPD.
